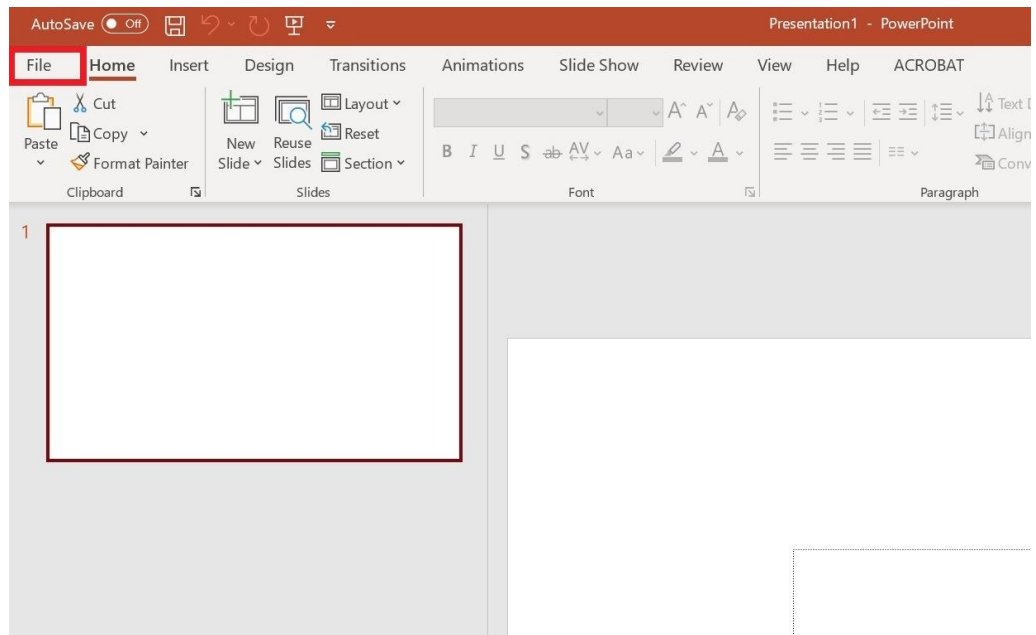


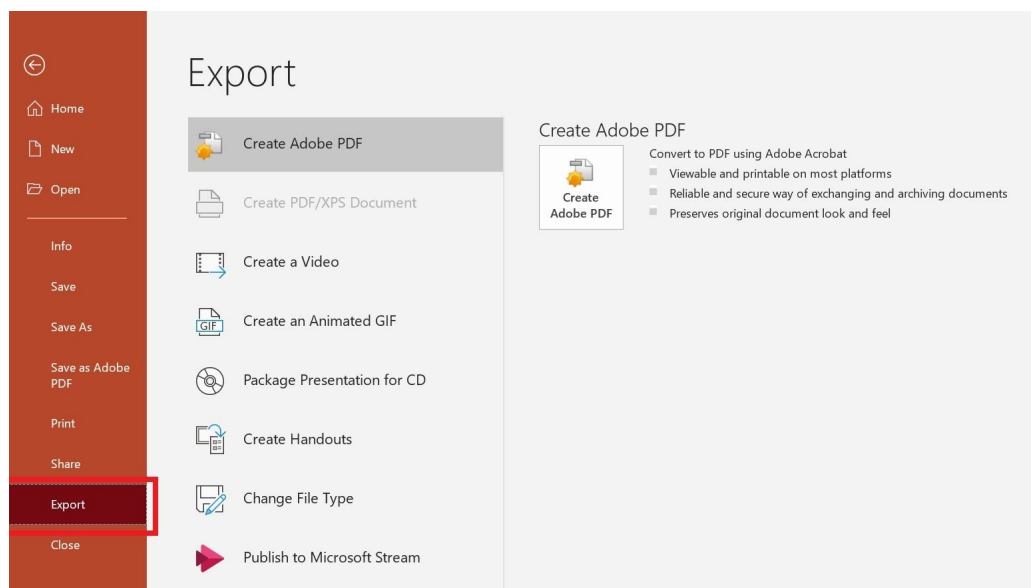
How to Convert a Powerpoint Presentation into a Kaltura Video

If you have a PowerPoint presentation with audio narration already created, it is simple to make this content available as a sharable video using Kaltura.

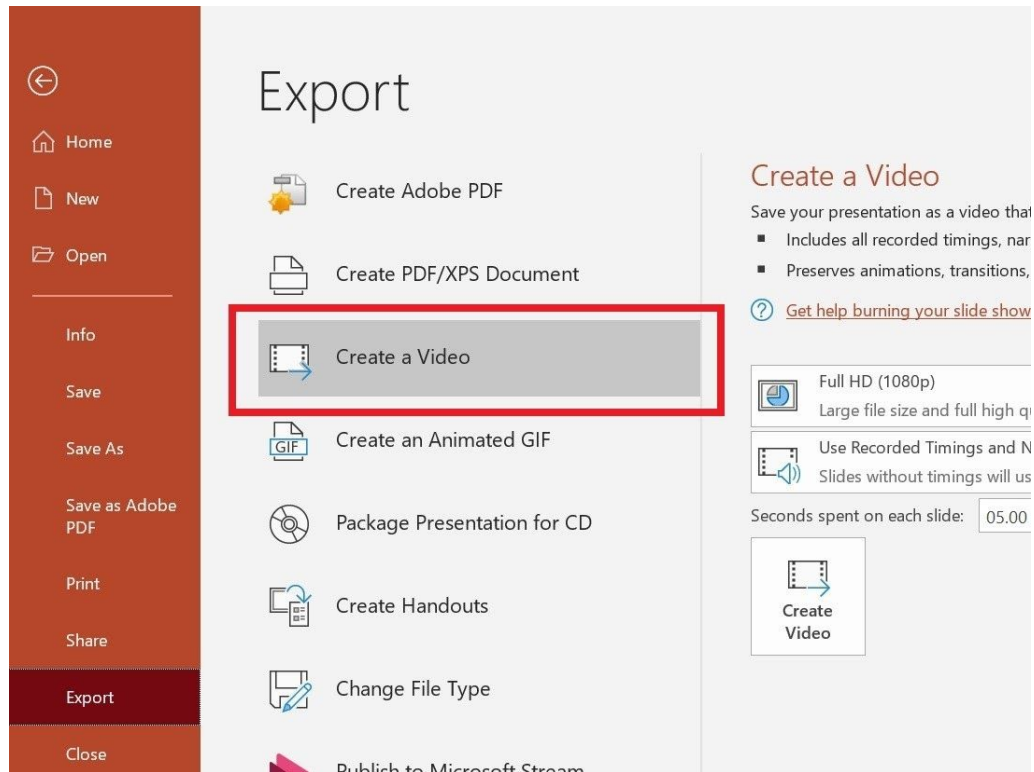
Open the PowerPoint presentation you wish to use and click the “File” tab.



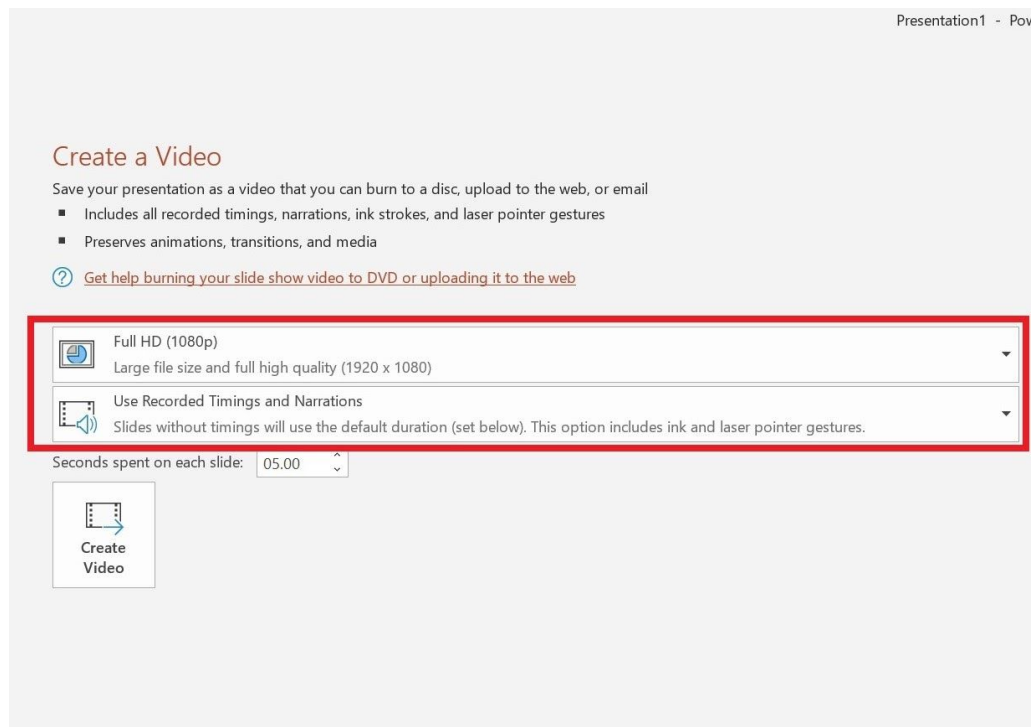
Click the “Export” feature towards the bottom of the left-hand navigation panel.



Click “Create a Video” from the list of options available under Export.



Be sure to set the video resolution to “Full HD (1080p)” and enable “Use Recorded Timings and Narrations” in order to capture your slide narration audio for export.



When your settings are complete, click “Create Video” and save your exported presentation as an MPEG-4 video file on your computer.

Save your presentation as a video that you can burn to a disc, upload to the web, or email
